**CORRIGENDUM ORDER**

The following corrections are made to the Multi-Year Tariff Order dated 21 October, 2016 in Case No. 34 of 2016 for Reliance Infrastructure Limited (Distribution Business):

1. The provision regarding **Load Factor Incentive** at pages 413, 443, 474, and 503 reads as follows:

*“...Consumers having a Load Factor above 85 % will be entitled to a rebate of 1% on the Wheeling Charges, Energy Charges, and Regulatory Asset Charge for every percentage point increase in Load Factor from 85%...”*

**This should be read as:**

*“...Consumers having a Load Factor above 85 % will be entitled to a rebate of 1% on the Energy Charges for every percentage point increase in Load Factor from 85%...”*

2. The Commission's Analysis and Ruling with regard to the **Power Factor Incentive and Penalty**, at para. 7.12.13 on page 377 of the Order, reads as follows:

*"The PF incentive/penalty is applicable to the LT Public Service category [both LT X (A) and LT X (B)]..."*

**This should be read as:**

*"The PF incentive/penalty is applicable to the LT Public Service category [both LT IX (A) and LT IX (B)] with Contract Demand/ Sanctioned Load above 20 kW only..."*

3. The provision regarding **Power Factor Incentive** at pages 411, 441, 472, and 501 of the Order reads as follows:

*"Applicable for... LT IX: Public Service [LT IX (A) and LT IX (B)]."*

**This should be read as:**

*"Applicable for... LT IX: Public Service [LT IX (A) and LT IX (B)] with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW only."*

4. The provision regarding **Power Factor Penalty** at pages 412, 442, 473, and 502 of the Order reads as follows:

*"Applicable for... LT IX: Public Service [LT IX (A) and LT IX (B)]."*

**This should be read as:**

*"Applicable for... LT IX: Public Service [LT IX (A) and LT IX (B)] with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW only."*

5. The Commission's Analysis and Ruling regarding the **Wheeling Charge** in Section 7.4 at page 334 of the Order reads as follows:

*"The Wheeling Charge for HT level short-term OA has been determined in terms of*

*Rs/kWh. However, for medium/long-term OA, the Wheeling Charges shall be applicable in terms of Rs/kW/month rather than Rs/kWh."*

**This should be read as:**

**"The Wheeling Charge for HT level short/medium/long-term OA has been determined in terms of Rs/kWh."**

6. **Table 7-36** at pages 334 and 335 reads as follows:

7. The Commission's Analysis and Ruling on the **Temporary tariff category** in Section 2.3 at pages 33 and 34 reads as follows:

*"...Beyond one year, the supply for Construction purposes shall be categorised under the Commercial category...."*

**This should be read as:**

*"...Beyond one year from the date of connection, the supply for Construction purposes shall be categorised under the Commercial category..."*

8. The provision on the **applicability of ToD Tariffs for LT categories** below the Tables in Section 7.8 at page 365, Section 7.9 at page 367, Section 7.10 at pages 369 and 370, and Section 7.11 at page 372 reads as follows :

*"ToD Tariffs (in addition to above base tariffs) – compulsory for LT II (B) and (C), LT III (B), LT IV and LT IX (A) and (B) categories, and optional for LT II (A) and LT III (A) categories."*

**This should be read as:**

*"ToD Tariffs (in addition to above base tariffs) – compulsory for LT II (B) and (C), LT III (B), LT IV (with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW) and LT IX (A) and (B) categories (with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW); and optional for LT II (A), LT III (A), LT IV and LT IX (A) and (B) categories (with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load up to 20 kW and having ToD meter installed)."*

9. The following clarificatory Note is added below the Tariff Tables for **LT IV: LT-Public Water Works (PWW) and Sewage Treatment Plants** at pages 395, 425, 456, and 486 of the Order:

**“Note:**

**The ToD Tariff is compulsorily applicable to the LT IV category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW; and optionally available to the LT IV category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load up to 20 kW having ToD meter installed.”**

10. The following clarificatory Note is added below the Tariff Tables for **LT IX (A): LT - Government Educational Institutions and Hospitals** at pages 399, 429, 460, and 490 of the Order:

**“Note:**

**The ToD Tariff is compulsorily applicable to the LT IX (A) category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW; and optionally available to the LT IX (A) category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load up to 20 kW having ToD meter installed.”**

11. The following clarificatory Note is added below the Tariff Tables for **LT IX (B): LT - Public Services - Others** at pages 400 and 401, 430 and 431, 461 and 462, and 491 of the Order:

**“Note:**

**The ToD Tariff is compulsorily applicable to the LT IX (B) category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load above 20 kW; and optionally available to the LT IX (B) category with Contract Demand/Sanctioned Load up to 20 kW having ToD meter installed.”**
